

WHAT IS GHS

GHS = Globally Harmonized System of Classification & Labeling of Chemicals.

GHS is a system that was created by the United Nations for standardizing the classification and labeling of chemicals throughout the world to protect employees and the general public. Under the GHS standard, labels include signal words, pictograms, hazard and precautionary statements on durable labels to ensure workers are informed and prevent dangers.

GHS section 3 CERTIFIED materials for Drum and Barrel Application

Section 3 certification is required on printed labels for durability and environmental resistance.
