



Beginning Jan 1, 2015 major parcel carriers will begin using **Dimensional Weight** to calculate Billable Weight of a package.

What impact will this have?

The Wall Street Journal estimates that under the new price model, shipping an eight pound 32 pack of toilet paper between 601 and 1,000 miles will increase the shipping cost 37%.
